



Big Bear Area Wild Burros

Burros found around Big Bear are considered **protected** under the federal [Wild Free-Roaming Horses and Burros Act](#), Chapter 30, Title 16 of the United States Code (commencing with Section 1331).

This limits San Bernardino County involvement in managing these burros.

For injured or deceased burros, residents can call San Bernardino County Animal Care at (800) 472-5609.

For severely injured or deceased burros impeding a roadway, dial 911.
