San Bernardino County Animal Care is partnering with The PAW Mission to provide free spay and neuter services to unincorporated residents!

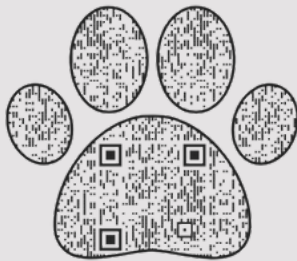
**This event is for the Trap, Neuter, Vaccinate, and Return (TNVR) program for Community Cats.**

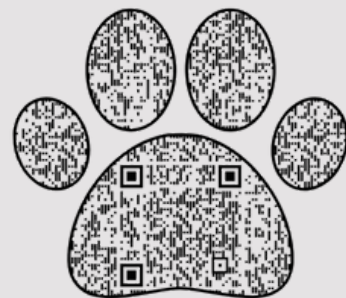

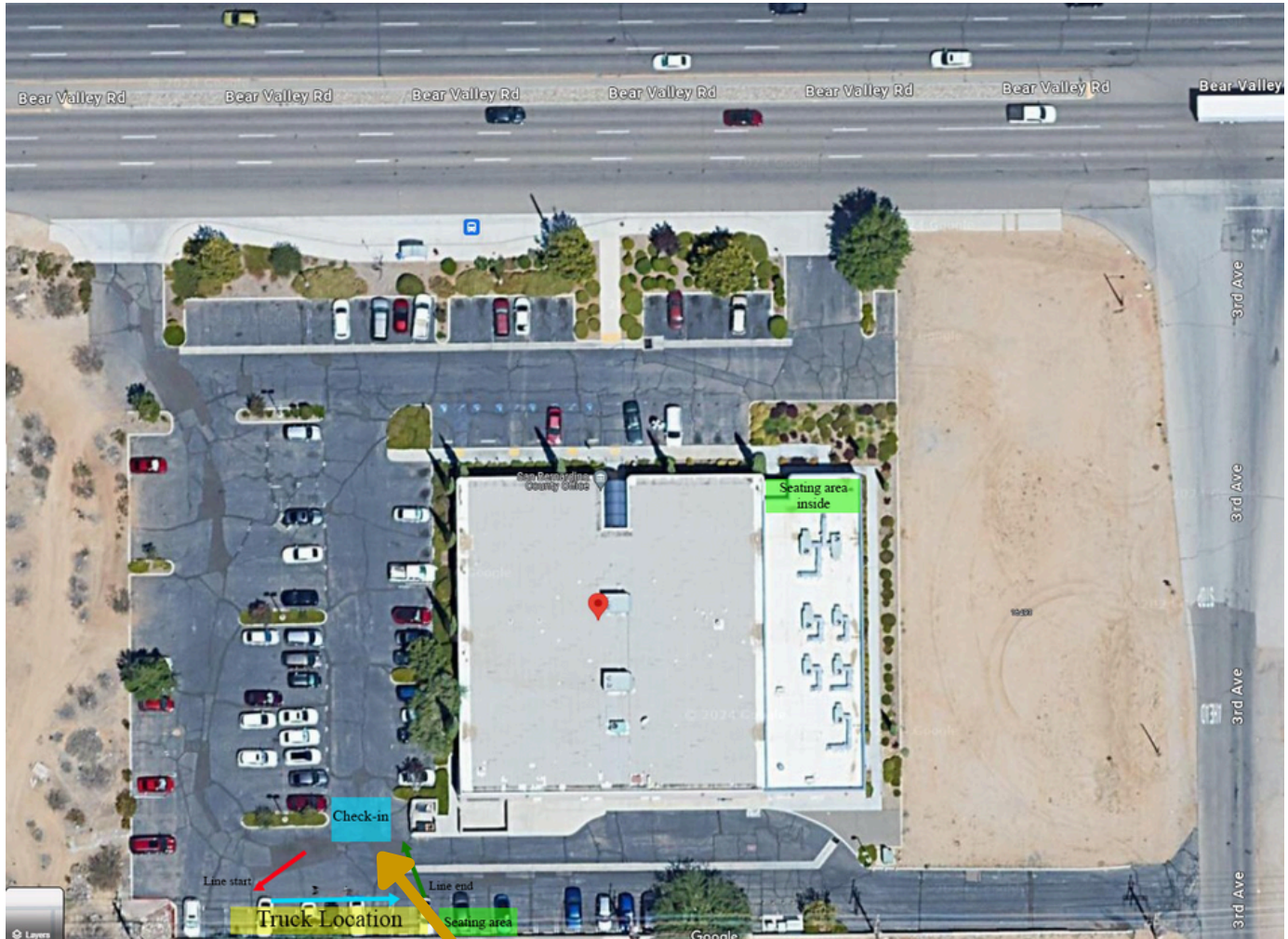
