

To qualify for the discounted licensing price, you will need to bring proof of your pet's spay/neuter. Additionally, proof of a previous rabies vaccine is required to receive a license. If your pet does not have proof of a rabies vaccine, they may receive the vaccine at the event before obtaining the license.

Vaccinations \$10 each

- FVRCP
- Leptospirosis
- Bordetella
- DA2PP
- Rabies

If you would like to receive a 3-year rabies vaccine instead of a 1-year vaccine, you must provide proof of the previous rabies vaccination.
